191 PROHIBITING THE USE OF COMPRESSION BRAKES

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BURNING OF GARBAGE, WASTE, ETC...;
AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERSIDE,
WYOMING.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or cause to be burned any garbage, waste, packing material, trash, discarded boxes or other material, outside of any incinerator, within the limits of the Town of Riverside without having first obtained written permission from any member of the Town Council. They shall grant such permission if, in their opinion, the burning of the above described materials can be accomplished without danger to adjoining property or undue contamination to the air in the vicinity. The Town shall not be held to assume any liability by reason of having granted permission to burn any materials mentioned herein if such burning should cause damage to other (peoples) person's property. The permission granted shall be valid for only forty-eight (48) hours from time of issuance.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus cost.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 152

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CONTROL OF CARS IN CROSS WALKS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCE #149 OF THE TOWN OF RIVERSIDE AND ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING THERE TO BE AND EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF RIVERSIDE.

Cross-walks: It is unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle into a marked cross-walk while occupied or about to be occupied by a pedestrian, or to park a vehicle in such a marked cross-walk.
