ORDINANCE NO. 5A

1902

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING DOGS.

BE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF RIVERSIDE.

Section 1. That the owner of every dog, bitch or whelp in the town of Riverside shall pay to the town the sum of Two Dollars (\$2) on or before the first day of December in each and every year on each male and the sum of Three Dollars (\$3) on or before the first day of December of each year for each slut or bitch owned by him or her, as a tax.

Section 2. The town shall furnish and deliver to each person a tag for each and every dog, bitch or whelp on which the tax is paid and the owner shall securely fasten the same to a collar and place the same on said animal.

Section 3. The town shall by its proper officers impound any dog, bitch or whelp found running at large on which such tax has not been paid or which is found without the tag as required in the preceding section 48 hours and if the owner or someone for its owner shall not pay said tax together with the additional sum of One Dollar (\$1) for the impounding of such dog, bitch, or whelp, the same shall be killed.

Section 4. It shall be the duty of every owner of any bitch or slut in this town to keep the same securely confined while in heat and it shall be the duty of any and all police officers to kill any bitch or slut found running at large in the town limits while in heat whether the tax has been paid or not.

ORDINANCE NO. 16A

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REENACT AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING DOG LICENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF RIVERSIDE.

Section 1. That the owner of every male dog or whelp shall pay to the Town of Riverside, on or before the First of May of each year, the sum of \$2.00 (two dollars) and the sum of \$3.00 (three dollars) per year for every female dog, as a tax.

Section 2. The town shall furnish and deliver to each person a tag for each and every dog, female and whelp on which the tax has been paid, and the owner shall securely fasten the tag to a collar and place the same on said animal.

Section 3. The town shall by its proper officers impound any dog, female or whelp found running at large, on which such tax has not been paid, for 48 hours, and if the owner or some one for the owner shall not pay said tax, together with the additional sum of \$1.00 (one dollar) for the impounding of such animal, the same shall be disposed of.

This ordinance shall be in effect on and after its passage.
Passed, approved and adopted this 3rd day of April, 1961.

CITY OF RIVERSIDE, WYOMING.
Ordinance # 109

Relating to Livestock inside the city limits.

It shall be unlawfull for any person to turn livestock loose anyplace in the city limits of the town.

Any damage to property caused by loose live stock, either by being turned loose or breaking out of a pasture or being loose for any other reason, shall be paid for by the owner of the said livestock. This shall include but not be limited to, damage to shrubs, fences, cess pools and water pipes or lines.

This ordinance will be in effect when passed by the city council of the town of Riverside, Wyoming.
