**ORDINANCE NO. 2A**

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING POLICE COURT, POLICE JUSTICE AND FEES AND PROCEDURE THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF RIVERSIDE.

Section 1. That there is hereby established in the Town of Riverside a Police Court.

Section 2. The duly appointed or elected, qualified and acting Justice of the Peace in and/or the precinct of Riverside in and for the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming is hereby declared to be the Police Justice for this town. His term of office shall be contemporaneous with his term as Justice of the Peace and he may be removed for similar causes for the removal of Justice of the Peace. He shall have exclusive Jurisdiction to hear and determine all cases arising under ordinances of the Town of Riverside. The practice before said Police Court shall when not provided by ordinance conform as near as possible to the provision of the Code applicable to Justices Courts.

Section 3. The Police Justice shall receive the same fees as are now allowed Justices of the Peace in criminal cases. The Marshall shall receive the same fees for making arrests, serving papers, attending court as are now allowed constables for similar services in Justices Courts. The town attorney shall receive a fee of two dollars (\$2) in case the defendant pleads guilty and five dollars (\$5) where the defendant pleads not guilty and a trial is had to be charged against the defendant as cost if he is found guilty, but in no case shall said fees or costs be charged against the Town of Riverside.

Section 4. The Mayor, Trustees, Marshall and Police as conservators of the peace are hereby authorized and empowered to make arrests with or without a warrant and take before the Police Justice, whom shall break or threaten to break the peace, and shall have Power to arrest in like without process any person who shall in their presence violated any ordinances of the said town and may detain or cause to be detained all persons so arrested over night or over the Sabbath, but such persons shall be taken before the Police Justice as soon as possible. Any officer when acting in this capacity as herein provided shall be entitled to receive the same fees as the Town Marshall for the same services.

Section 5. The amount of the bond for the appearance of the person so arrested shall in no case exceed the sum of two hundred

dollars (\$200) and if the principal in said bond shall fail to appear at the time and place set forth in said bond or having appeared shall depart the said court without leave, the Police Justice shall make upon the bond and issue a summons in behalf of the Town of Riverside against the surety or sureties on said bond and on trial of the issue thus made the same defense shall be allowed for the non appearance of the principal that is allowed under the Revised Statutes of Wyoming.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
